ANTI-CORRUPTION STATEMENT

The Department of Civil Aviation (DCA), being a regulatory body and a service provider for Air Navigation Services is tasked to ensure the safety and security of civil aviation activities in Mauritius and the airspace under its jurisdiction. This responsibility vis-à-vis our national and international air operator and aviation stakeholders does not allow any margin for any type of wrong practice. Thus, in the decision-making process, DCA has no option than to address issues professionally, based strictly on technical and operational considerations, and applying them with fairness, integrity and discipline – as enshrined in our Customer Charter amongst our “Core Values”.

In order to competently discharge the heavy responsibilities conferred upon us through the various legislations, DCA is committed to working within a framework that promotes a sustainable and sound anti-corruption environment.

Management is determined to:

- ensure no compromise and no impairment to safety and security;
- uphold the principles of good governance;
- establish adequate procedures, systems and practices to prevent mismanagement and corruption in the Department and to safeguard public funds, assets and interest;
- ensure periodical review of these procedures, systems and practices;
- develop and maintain effective controls and checks for corruption prevention, detection and deterrence; and
- respond quickly and efficiently to indications that may lead to corruption and malpractices if not taken care of timely.

Every employee of this Department is required, at all times, to:

- act with fairness, integrity and discipline in the daily use/handling of public resources in his/her custody;
- comply with procedures, systems and practices which are in place; and
- report immediately to the Director of Civil Aviation any case where there may be indications of a dubious act.

Any deviation from this policy will be subjected to disciplinary action.
