Subject: Identification of passengers travelling by air to and from Rodrigues

1.0 Purpose of the Aviation Security Directive

1.1 This Aviation Security Directive is issued pursuant to provisions of Section 19 of the Civil Aviation (Security) Regulations 2008 for guidance and necessary action to be taken in respect of identification of passengers travelling to and from Rodrigues.

2.0 Arrangements

2.1 With effect from **14 July 2014**, the following procedures will apply in relation to identification of passengers travelling by air to and from Rodrigues:

- a) Foreign national to produce his/her valid passport.
- b) Mauritian national of full age to produce either a valid passport or a National Identity Card.
- c) For accompanied minors, in the absence of a valid passport, parents to produce birth certificate or a valid bus pass or other identification document issued by a recognised Educational/ Training institution.
- d) Unaccompanied minors will be required to produce a valid passport or a valid bus pass or other identification document issued by a recognised Educational/Training Institution.
- e) In the absence of the above mentioned documents, a minor to produce an identity document issued by the Police Station of his/her locality.

The collaboration of everyone is sought for the enhancement of aviation security.
