## INTERNSHIP/TRAINING IN THE SECURITY RESTRICTED AREA OF THE SSR INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

## 1.0 Purpose of the Aviation Security Directive

- 1.1 This Aviation Security Directive is issued pursuant to provisions of section 19 of the Civil Aviation (Security) Regulations 2008 for guidance and necessary action to be taken in respect of application for ASICs for the purpose of internship/training in the Security Restricted Areas (SRA) of the Sir Seewoosagur Ramgoolam International Airport.
- 2.0 Arrangements
- 2.1 With effect from 01 November 2011 the following arrangements will apply in relation to requests for internship/training in the SRA of the SSR International Airport:
- Applications for the conduct of internship/training in the SRA will only be accepted from students/trainees sponsored by a recognised academic institution based in Mauritius. Students/trainees from foreign based institutions will not be allowed internship/training in the SRA.
- 2.3 Airport based organisations planning to receive students/trainees for internship/training must apply for ASICs in favour of the students/trainees supporting the application by the following:
  - (i) a bona fide certificate from the recognized academic institution certifying the field of study in which internship is required,
  - (ii) the scope of study with details of content of the training programme, and
  - (iii) a recommendation letter from the airport based organization, mentioning its responsibility vis-à-vis the students/trainees, including insurance and escorting requirements during internship/training.

2.4 Application for internship must be made to the Director of Civil Aviation affording at least 30 days advance notice.
