

3. Charter / Special flights

3.3 Overfly and Technical stop

Charter / Special flights overflying the Mauritius Flight Information Region or making a technical stop in the Republic of Mauritius require prior permission. The operator should make an application to the Director of Civil Aviation at least 24 hours in advance of the intended landing and should submit the following information:

- 1 Name, telephone number, email and postal address of operator;
- 2 Name and contact details of operator's representative available in the event of an emergency on H24 including landline and mobile telephone number (including country and area codes); Fax numbers; Email addresses; AFTN addresses; & SITA addresses;
- 3 Billing address of operator (email and postal addresses);
- 4 Type of aircraft and registration mark(s);
- 5 Aircraft call-sign;
- 6 Schedule: route(s), date(s), timing(s) of operations;
- 7 Copy of insurance certificate;
- 8 Statement from airlines that their aircraft have equipments on board and maintained in an airworthiness condition as per provision of Annex 6 - Operations of Aircraft, Part I - International Commercial Air Transport- Aeroplanes, Chapter 6 - Aeroplane Instruments, Equipments and flight document and Chapter 7 - Aeroplane Communication and Navigation Equipment
- 9 Noise Certificate of the aircraft.
