THE CIVIL AVIATION ACT

Regulations made by the Minister under section 11(1) of the Civil Aviation Act

- **1.** These regulations may be cited as the Civil Aviation (Amendment) Regulations 2023.
- 2. In these regulations
 - "principal regulations" means the Civil Aviation Regulations 2007.
- **3.** Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is amended by inserting, in the appropriate alphabetical order, the following new definition
 - "heliport" means an aerodrome or a defined area on a structure intended to be used wholly or in part for the arrival, departure and surface movement of helicopters;
- **4.** Regulation 103C of the principal regulations is amended
 - (a) by deleting the heading and replacing it by the following heading –

103C. Heliport

- (b) by deleting the word "helipad" wherever it appears and replacing it by the word "heliport".
- **5.** The Second Schedule to the principal regulations is amended by deleting item 39 and replacing it by the following item –

39. Heliport under regulation 103C

(1) Issue of approval 125,000

(2) Renewal of approval 75,000

- **6.** Any approval for a helipad granted under regulation 103C(5) shall remain valid for a period of 12 months from the date of coming into operation of these regulations.
- 7. These regulations shall come into operation on 17 July 2023.
