# APPLICATION FOR VALIDATION OF FOREIGN ICAO FLIGHT CREW LICENCE

## Introduction

The aim of this Guidance and Checklist is to open a channel of discussion in creating a standard practice and understanding of the validation of foreign licences to enable DCA to achieve their MCAR-FCL obligations in validating licences in accordance with Civil Aviation Regulation 2007 as amended.

The mechanism of validation is quite detailed in the MCAR and rely a lot on the information provided by the foreign issuing authority. However, some challenges persist and some clarifications are necessary for the countries to align the practice and understanding of the terminology involved

#### Validity of validation certificate

6 (Six) months or until expiry of the foreign pilot licence whichever is the earlier and renewable only once from the date of Air Law test.

#### General

- 1. This application form will take approximately 15 minutes to complete. Incomplete applications will not be processed.

3. For the purpose of authenticating your foreign licence, depending on your Licensing Authority, you may need to inform your Licensing Authority to release the relevant licensing information upon our request.

### Collection

- 4. Processing of the validation certificate would take approximately 7 working days subject to positive authentication from the foreign licensing Authority.
- 5. You will be notified when the licence is ready for collection.
