Signage Installation and markings works for Standby Runway at Sir Seewoosagur Ramgoolam International airport

1. Introduction

This AIP Supplement is a follow up of the AIC 02/20 issued regarding the construction of a Standby Runway at Sir Seewoosagur Ramgoolam International airport. The works will comprise of obliterating existing taxiway Yankee markings and replacing with runway markings as well as implementation of new signs and modification of existing signs.

2. Details of facilities affected

Markings

During the works some of the markings may remain incomplete. They will be notified through NOTAM and, if required, a Follow Me vehicle will be provided to guide the aircraft.

Signs

Since the Taxiway Signages are powered from the same source, all signages will be down during the electrical connection works. Connections works will be carried out outside aircraft movement. If a sign has not been fixed, it will be notified through a NOTAM.

From 21 to 25 February 2021 during the installation and replacement of signages and electrical connections, if works are not completed on time, Airfield Section will provide "FOLLOW ME" vehicle to guide aircraft.
