Application for Renewal of Schedule flights to Mauritius

The Department of Civil Aviation hereby informs all foreign airlines operating to Mauritius that their applications for the renewal of scheduled operations to Mauritius (IATA Summer and Winter Schedule) must be submitted to the Director of Civil Aviation at least two (02) months prior to the intended date of operation in accordance with AIP Mauritius GEN 1.2 Paragraph 2.3.

Airlines are reminded that clearance from the Department of Civil Aviation must be obtained before submitting any slot requests to AML. The slot requests to AML shall reflect the exact number of weekly flights which have been approved.

Applications for renewal of scheduled operations must include the following information:

- a) Name, telephone number, email and postal address of operator;
- b) Name and contact details of operator's representative available in the event of an emergency on H24 including landline and mobile telephone number (including country and area codes); Fax numbers; Email addresses; AFTN addresses; & SITA addresses;
- c) Billing address of operator (email and postal addresses);
- d) Aircraft registration marks;
- e) Aircraft type;
- f) Capacity/configuration of aircraft;
- g) Aircraft call-sign;
- h) Schedule: route(s), date(s) and timings of operations;
- i) Noise Certificate of the aircraft; and

- j) Statement from airlines that their aircraft have necessary insurance cover, equipment on board and maintained in an airworthiness condition as per provision of Annex 6 – Operations of Aircraft, Part I – International Commercial Air Transport – Aeroplanes, Chapter 6 – Aeroplane Instruments, equipments and flight document and Chapter 7 – Aeroplane Communication and Navigation Equipment

In addition, airlines should note that:

- Documentation for all additional aircraft must be submitted prior to their use.
- Validity of documents: if any document expires during the approved operations, operators shall submit renewed documentation without delay.
- Processing of requests will commence only upon receipt of all required information.

Airlines are reminded that non-compliance with these requirements may result in delays in processing the applications and obtaining an approval, which may in turn affect slot clearance with AML.

The cooperation of all airlines is sought to ensure the smooth and safe conduct of scheduled operations to Mauritius.
