6. Cargo flights

6.4 Technical stop in Mauritius

If an operator intends to make a technical stop at Sir Seewoosagur Ramgoolam International Airport with a cargo flight, he shall apply to the Director of Civil Aviation at least 1 day prior to operations of the flight.

- 1. Name, telephone number, email and postal address of operator;
- 2. Name and contact details of operator's representative available in the event of an emergency on H24 including landline and mobile telephone number (including country and area codes); Fax numbers; Email addresses; AFTN addresses; & SITA addresses;
- 3. Billing address of operator (email and postal addresses);
- 4. Type of aircraft and registration mark(s);
- 5. Aircraft call-sign;
- 6. Purpose of flight;
- 7. Type of cargo on board;
- 8. Aerodrome/country of origin;
- 9. Aerodrome/country of destination;
- 10. Schedule: route(s), date(s), timing(s) of operations;
- 11. Noise Certificate of aircraft; and
- 12. Statement from airlines that their aircraft have the necessary insurance cover, equipments on board and maintained in an airworthiness condition as per provision of Annex 6 Operations of Aircraft, Part I International Commercial Air Transport-Aeroplanes, Chapter 6 Aeroplane Instruments, Equipments and flight document and Chapter 7 Aeroplane Communication and Navigation Equipment.
